Kingman County, KS Uses Millions in Wind Farm Revenue to Protect Citizens

Wind funds used to invest in Law Enforcement, Fire Services and Roads

LAW ENFORCEMENT

\$300,000 for renovations to the Kingman County Law Enforcement Center.

FIRE PROTECTION

A \$300,000 grant from wind funds to Cunningham to enhance fire protection services.

ROADS

Additional funds from the wind farm to improve roads and support fire protection.

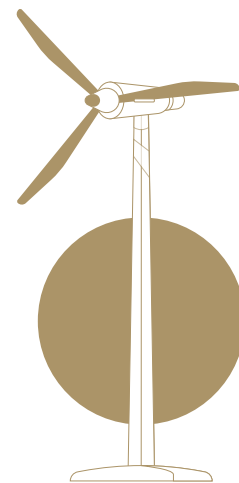
